**Ministries that Receive our Offerings – 2009-2010
(listed in alphabetical order)**

Alpha Center is an agency that provides a comprehensive range of services to women and men involved in an unplanned pregnancy.

ATLAS of Sioux Falls is a non-denominational, faith-based ministry that helps hurting people by walking beside them, loving them and one-on-one mentoring.

Back To God Ministries International is a denominational broadcast ministry.

Banquet The Banquet serves meals many times a week to those needing a meal. Anyone who comes in is served a meal.

Ben and Amy Meyer are missionaries with CR World Missions. Shalom supports their ministry in Guadalajara, Mexico.

Bethany Christian Services is a national organization that seeks to help families. They counsel women with unplanned pregnancies and facilitate adoptions. Bethany has an office in Sioux Falls.

Bethesda Midwest is a nationwide Christian counseling service. Fees are pro-rated according to income. The local office is called Bethesda Midwest.

Bible League is an organization that provides Scriptures and training worldwide so that people prepared by the Holy Spirit will be brought into the fellowship of Christ and His church. Shalom will be supporting two church-planting pastors in their native countries.

Cadets is a denomination-wide boys' club. Shalom has an active club. They study the Bible and Christian living, learn life skills, and share a variety of activities together.

Calvin Seminary is the denominational seminary. All Christian Reformed Church pastors must attend there at least one year. This is part of our Ministry Shares.

Center of Hope reaches out to people in the Sioux Falls area who have difficult life issues.

Christian Schools International advances Christian education and supports schools in their tasks by providing publications, promotional materials, curriculum, and employee benefit programs.

Community Outreach is an agency in which the Sioux Falls churches unite to help those with various needs (housing, food, clothing, etc.). This agency gives the churches a resource and information center in the city.

Cornerstone Prison Ministry is a local ministry at the SD State Penitentiary.

CRC Home Missions is a denominational ministry to the unsaved in North America.

Crossroad Bible Institute is a devotional ministry to prisoners.

CR World Missions seeks to reach the unsaved around the world. This is a denominational world outreach.

CRWRC is a relief, development, and educational ministry of the Christian Reformed Church in North America and partners with local agencies that understand local needs. Together CRWRC and its partners find ways to provide lasting change for people in more than 30 countries around the world.

CRWRC Grain Resource Bank Farmers and churches partner together to harvest grain. The farmer provides the land, the labor, and the equipment; the churches pay a small rent to the farmer and pay for the seed, fertilizer, etc. When the grain is harvested, the profit is monetized and the money is used directly to assist farmers in third-world countries.

CRWRC World Hunger works year-round to eliminate hunger. However, once a year they specifically ask for an offering which is used to fight world hunger.

Dawson McAllister is a national organization dedicated to today's youth. It is a place on the radio where teenagers and young adults can tell their story, receive support and encouragement and be assured they are not alone.

Furniture Mission is an organization in Sioux Falls that provides furniture to those who are unable to purchase it.

GEMS is a denomination-wide girls' club. Shalom has an active club. They study the Bible and Christian living, learn life skills, and share a variety of activities together.

Gideons is an international ministry that seeks to spread the good news of salvation by placing Bibles in the hands of the people.

Good Shepherd Center is an ecumenical ministry serving homeless, poor and needy members of the community.

Hope Haven is a Christian School, training center, and work center for the handicapped. It is located in Rock Valley, IA, and also has a branch in Sioux Falls where wheelchairs are refurbished and sent to people in need around the world.

Justice For All is a ministry to better the lives of people through building projects and renovations. Projects are determined and teams are sent to paint, hammer, clean up, and whatever else is needed. They also have a warehouse for used clothing and furniture in Rock Valley, IA.

Luke Society is an international medical ministry. Their work covers the globe. Their home office is in Sioux Falls.

Ministry Shares are the gifts we send to the denominational offices to support ministries of the Christian Reformed Church.

Minn-I-Kota Youth is a regional youth organization. Shalom's youth and youth leaders are involved with this organization.

New Life Treatment Center is a Christian counseling service for those struggling with addictions. It is located in Woodstock, MN.

New Roots exists to serve the immigrant and refugee population of Sioux Falls, assisting them with their physical, spiritual, and emotional needs and serving as a link between the Anglo evangelical church in the SF area and the immigrant/refugee pastors and churches.

Shalom Benevolence Fund is maintained by the Shalom diaconate to provide financial assistance to those in need.

Shalom General Fund is the operating budget of our church. It pays for staff, utilities, educational materials, maintenance, etc.

Sioux Falls Christian Schools provides Christian elementary/middle/high school education in Sioux Falls.

Sioux Falls Christian Schools Tuition Aid Fund These offerings are sent directly to SFCS. They are distributed to families who have applied and qualify for tuition assistance.

Sioux Falls Food Pantry is a local organization that provides groceries to people in need.

Transport for Christ is a non-profit, non denominational Christian organization that leads truck drivers as well as the trucking community to Jesus Christ and helps them grow in their faith. The local chapel is at the Pilot Truck Stop in Sioux Falls.

Union Gospel Mission is in Sioux Falls. It seeks to change the hearts and lives of its residents. They offer the gospel, meals, beds, education, and encouragement.

Youth Unlimited is the denominational ministry to the youth of our church.
